B. Rates for Extended Hours:

- 7:30AM - 9:00AM \$150 for a full term of 7 weeks
- 3:00PM - 6:00PM \$300 for a full term of 7 weeks
- After 6PM, \$3 per half hour late fee.
- An additional \$100 will be assessed for full day students who wish to enroll in writing in the afternoon.

C. Transportation Expenses (collected on behalf of the school bus operator)

- The Center makes arrangements only for school bus transportation to and from school. The rate quoted by the operator is \$60 per week (two way), \$35 per week (one way).
- Morning students will have to make their own arrangements for the home-bound trip. Afternoon students are to make their own arrangements for school-bound transportation. No transportation is provided after 3:00PM. Parents' understanding would be deeply appreciated.

**** Registered by March 30th, 2010 and receive a \$50 dollar per full-day student or \$25 per half-day student****

D. Discounts:

- Each current student who registers before April 30th will receive \$20 off (half-day students) or \$40 off (full-day students).
- Students who register before May 30th will receive \$10 off (half-day students) or \$15 off (full-day students).
- Get an additional \$20 discount for each registered ****new student**** recommended.
- Second child in the same family receives \$20 off his or her tuition. Third child receives a \$30 discount off his or her tuition.
- **Early registration discounts cannot be combined and only students who register for the entire 7-weeks of camp are eligible.**

NB. Once registered, the registration fee is non-refundable. After the commencement of the summer camp, tuition and fees are non-refundable for absence, leaves and/or withdrawals. A \$25 administrative charge is levied for any bounced check. Your understanding would be most appreciated.
